Demographic Report of Initiated Traffic Stops and Annual Review

2021

In 2021 the Ada Police Department collected data related to race and gender of the drivers involved in officer-initiated traffic stops. Our officers are required to collect race and gender on each officer-initiated traffic stop by sight or driver’s license information only. We do not ask for the race or gender of the driver. Entries are made on Daily Activity Logs, collated, and reported to the Chief of Police monthly. We reviewed 704 traffic stops and noted the following breakdown:

Race Gender	Raw Number	Percentage
White Male Driver	375	53.2%
White Female Driver	247	35%
Black Male Driver	36	5.1%
Black Female Driver	12	1.7%
Other (Unknown/Not Reported)	34	4.8%

According to the U.S. Census Population Estimate for July 1, 2021 the Village of Ada is comprised of the following Race and Gender breakdown:

Race and Hispanic Origin

- White alone - 84.4%
- Black or African American alone - 3.6%
- American Indian and Alaska Native alone - 0.0%
- Asian alone - 3.5%
- Native Hawaiian and Other Pacific Islander - 0.0%
- Two or More Races - 4.8%
- Hispanic or Latino - 5.9%
- White alone, not Hispanic or Latino - 83.0%

Gender

- Male – 50.4%
- Female – 49.6%
